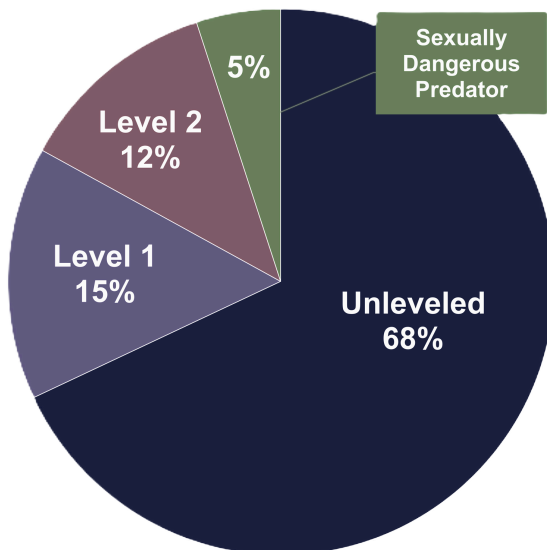

Georgia registrants are categorized
into three levels



1,000 Feet

Most registrants cannot **live or work** within 1,000 feet of schools, childcare facilities, and churches.

Georgia is one of the only states to include **churches** on that list.

Georgia is one of the only states to have **employment** distance restrictions.

Registry removal is possible

Registrants may petition for removal in some situations. For most, they must:

- Have completed all prison, parole, supervised release, and probation
- Be classified as Level 1
- Meet the criteria set forth in GA Code § 17-10-6.2 (c)(1)(A) through (c)(1)(F)
